MUNDARING AND HILLS
HISTORICAL SOCIETY

This appears to be as good a time as any to initiate a magazine to cover articles and notices related to the Mundaring and Hills Historical Society. The distribution will increase from this limited edition for members of the working committee to as many members of the Society who join when it is established.

The first meeting of the working committee representing the to be formed Mundaring and Hills Historical Society was held at my residential address on Saturday, 15th July, 1989.

Those persons who were able to attend participated and contributed to decisions necessary to the establishment of the Society. Items on the agenda that were discussed at the meeting with the subsequent results were:

- a. Appointment of temporary office bearers. Until the Society is officially formed, I can continue to fulfill many of the responsibilities of managing and organising the affairs of The Society. But as can be understood, this is not feasible nor allowed in a functioning organisation. Prior to the next meeting and the inaugural Public Meeting, please consider seriously if you could contribute to this field. For the Historical Society to be strong and functional, it must have dedicated members.
- b. Most of the required prerequisites to formally establish the Historical Society have been completed. Upon matters covered in the last meeting being documented and another meeting to ensure the details are complete and correct, the Inaugural Public Meeting can be called.

- c. It was decided at the meeting to adopt the name "Mundaring and Hills Historical Society".
- d. The Constitution to be adopted was read out with those members present contributing to the areas which required discussion. This Constitution will be typed to include all details appropriate. This will be the Constitution read out and adopted at the Inaugural Meeting.
- e. The fee structure agreed upon for the first financial year is:

One person	\$ 8.00
Husband and wife	\$10.00
Pensioner Single	\$ 6.00
Pensioner Couple	\$ 8.00
Junior (non voting)	\$ 6.00

- f. I have submitted a request to Mair and Co., the agents representing the Developers of the new Proposed Shopping Centre in Mundaring, to acquire the old School House for a museum. Receipt of my submission has been received, but any decision will not be forthcoming till the future of all buildings on the site has been determined. If this building can be obtained, it will make a good start to establishing a permanent base for the Society.
- g. I encourage you to seek and encourage others to join the Mundaring and Hills Historical Society. You can ask them to attend the next informal meeting to get first hand knowledge of the Society or simply show them a copy of this journal. Whichever way you convince them this Society has a worthwhile cause, follow the interest through, by ensuring they attend one of the Society's activities.

- g. We need active, enthusiastic members to ensure the aims of the Society are achieved.
- h. Soon articles of historical interest will be submitted to the local paper to generate interest in the community. This will prelude the announcement of the Inaugral Public Meeting. If any person is interested in or has information pertanent to the writing of such articles, please get in touch with me. These articles will contribute to the arousing of public awareness in local history and encourage new members.
- i. We have received an invitation from the Kalamunda Historical Society to organise an excursion to visit their Historical Village. This arrangement of museums is extremely interesting and is planned to be the first such activity of our to be formed Society. Further discussions will occur at the next meeting to organise the details for this excursion. It is very encouraging to see what can be done with the appropriate support and resources.
